I hope everyone enjoyed the snow storm this week. I know the kids (and the staff) were excited about the first snowstorm of the season!

In celebration of reading week, we hosted our semi-annual Scholastic Book Fair - which has gone exceedingly well. The kids love the opportunity to shop for books. All the students were challenged this past week to read, read, read. The top reader (logged the most minutes reading for the week) from each homeroom will be treated to a pizza party next Friday. We have extended the challenge to Monday, March 6th due to the snow day.

Today we began Stations of the Cross, a meditative journey as we follow Christ to the Cross. Father Barrow leads the school community in the Stations of the Cross every Friday throughout the Lenten season.

Scholarship Opportunity for Upcoming Middle School Students

The Rhode Island Foundation is pleased to announce that applications are now being accepted for the **Horace and Reverend E. Naomi Craig Scholarship Fund**.

The scholarships are available to middle school students, grades 6-8, who wish to attend an independent or parochial school. Applicants currently in 5th, 6th or 7th grade are eligible to apply with proof of acceptance to an accredited school. Preference is given to students from the Sheldon Street Church community, regardless of address, or Providence's Fox Point Neighborhood. Awards are generally in the \$1,000 range and are renewable for up to three years. Renewals must create a new application.
