It was also the time where we took the opportunity to announce our class valedictorians and salutatorian. We had a tie for valedictorian. ## Instructions for Creating a Family Portal Login

- Please go to [FACTS Family Portal](#)
- Select **Create New Family Portal Account**
- **District Code: STS-RI**
- Enter your email address as provided in your application to the school.
- Click **Create Account**
- You will receive an email from FACTS Customer Support containing a link that will allow you to create your username and password. For security purposes this link will remain active for 6 hours.
- Log into Family Portal as instructed above.

Our Enrollment system will open with a link to the enrollment packet for your child. The process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later. If you have any questions, please contact our office.
