# **Principal Update**

Good Afternoon STS Families,

I am sure that by now everyone is busy getting ready for Thanksgiving. This week our students collected canned goods for a local food pantry (Saint Vincent de Paul at Saint Jahn Paul II) and today we delivered more than **600 canned goods** for the benefit of those who are struggling. Thank you everyone who sent in canned goods.

We finally finished counting shoes – all total we have collected 1,321 pairs of shoes. We would like to collect another 679 pairs and will be reaching out into the community for support.

I am pleased to announce that we have hired a **kindergarten teacher** – Kim Pierce. Kim has a BA from Bridgewater State College and advanced certification in Art Education (k-8). She founded and ran Little Explorers Family

Childcare Program and is certified as a lead teacher. Last week she spent the day with kindergarten and had the opportunity to meet the children and some of the parents during the walk-a-thon. We welcome her to the STS community. She will be starting next Tuesday. We would also like to take this opportunity to thank Mrs. Hardy for having done such a nice job with kindergarten for the past two months. We look forward to Mrs. Pierce and Mrs. Hardy partnering together as they continue to offer a quality program to our kindergarten students.

The first trimester ends on November 30th. At the conclusion of the first term, we provide an opportunity for parents to come in and meet with the teachers. Our **parent conference night** will be Tuesday, December 5th from 2:30 to 5:30. Your child's teacher will be reaching out to schedule a meeting time. If you are unable to attend that day, your child's teacher will be more than happy to accommodate with another meeting date. Please know that the meeting will be brief so that all parents will have the opportunity to meet.

**The CPR/First aid program** for grade 8 students (who have already signed up) is scheduled for November 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. We are excited to be offering this opportunity as part of a life skills program.

On December 9<sup>th</sup>, the parent council will be hosting our annual **Christmas tree lighting**. Please join us for the 4:00 mass at Saint Teresa's parish. The tree lighting (with refreshments) will follow outside after mass at 5:00. Each class has a theme and will be decorating a Christmas tree the week before the lighting – teachers may be reaching out for items to decorate with.

The **annual Christmas concert** will be on December 14th. Like last year, we will have two concerts that evening – pre-kindergarten through grade 2 will perform from 5:45pm to 6:15pm. And grades 3 through 8 will perform starting at 6:45pm. Specific directions concerning dress code, arrival etc. will be sent in a separate email.

We are looking to develop an **in-school tutoring program** to work with students who are struggling (specifically with reading and math). This program will include one new staff person and volunteers. If you know someone who may be interested either in the position or in volunteering, please have them contact me at <u>smansfield@stteresapawtucket.org</u>. Retired educators would be ideal for this program.

**Santa's Workshop** will be open soon! We are including the schedule for classes to shop, and we will definitely need donations and volunteers. Gift bags are a great need, and we really need parents to help our young shoppers; we need volunteers to bag gifts and to serve as cashiers. We will have items priced between \$3 and \$10 and we will be introducing a lot of new items this year. Please remember that volunteers must have a BCI (through our office) and Safe Environment training.

I am pleased to announce that we are once again offering the **Holiday Card Raffle**. We are hoping for 100% participation; and like the Walk-a-thon, we do not expect families to buy the cards themselves. We are hoping that you will sell them – at work, to friends and family. We are asking each student to sell five cards. For every five cards that a student sells, they will be entered into two drawings- one for a **television** and one for a **chrome book**. Other incentives may follow!


