Dear Families,

Last week I mentioned in the weekly newsletter that the staff was receiving training in ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter and Evacuate). This month at our October assembly the Pawtucket Police will be presenting to our students (October 20) in a fashion that is age appropriate. We are presently working with the Pawtucket Police to schedule an ALICE workshop for parents. When we have more information on this, we will let you know. We are all concerned with safety and want to assure you that Saint Teresa School engages in best practices.

With fall, comes lots of wonderful fall activities. The PTO will be running their annual Trunk or Treat on the 20th, the middle school will be having a pumpkin decorating contest and pre-k through grade 5 will have the opportunity to decorate pumpkins in school. Fundraising efforts are underway - our next big project is to raise funds to replace the existing whiteboards in all the classrooms. date we have collected 328 pairs and we hope to reach the goal of 4,000 pairs. Please ask families and friends to join in this effort. We can raise \$2,000 by collecting 4,000 pairs of shoes. If we are successful with this, one classroom will be completed. We are preparing to start Penny Wars between the classes - more information to follow within the next week. In November we will be holding our first annual Turkey Trot (November 10). More information will be coming on this as well.
