# **Principal Update**

#### Hi Everyone,

We've had another great week at Saint Teresa's. Yesterday was Mercy Day, which is an annual event that is celebrated by Bayview Academy in honor of Mercy Foundress Catherine McAuley. In celebration of this very special day, Bayview Academy sent five student volunteers to Saint Teresa's school as volunteers. These wonderful young ladies - one of whom was a Saint Teresa School graduate - spent the day working with our students on our monthly STEAM project. This month's STEAM Project was the Black Box. With the Black Box activity, students were presented with a box that had some unidentified items in it and students had to use their senses to try and figure out what was in the box. It was a challenge to all!

Tuesday was National Pirate's Day and of course we joined the festivities with our students dressing and talking like pirates. The parent council sponsored the event and brought our students Pirate's Booty Popcorn and gold coin candies for a snack. Thank you parent council!

Our middle school has had two new courses introduced this year- Latin and Public Speaking. The decision was made to offer Latin because research indicates that students who study Latin improve their vocabulary, reading and writing skills. Each week students are introduced to Latin root words and then they identify English word derivatives. Public speaking, though often dreaded, is an incredibly important communication skill. Because it is such an important skill, we have introduced it into our curriculum. Students seem to be having a positive response to both courses.


