Principal Update

Hi Everyone,

The administration and staff of Saint Teresa are always concerned with creating the safest of environments for our children. This means that we constantly assess the school for safety and take advantage of training opportunities. In keeping with this, today the faculty and staff underwent an ALICE Training by the Pawtucket Police Department. ALICE is an acronym for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter and Evacuate. These are procedures used in an instance of an intruder in the school. We hope and pray that there will never be an occasion to use this training, but we do need to be trained and prepared. Safety is always our number one priority. Next month, at our monthly assembly, students will also be trained in ALICE. The training will be appropriate to the age of the children.



Monday is Saint Teresa's Feast Day. In recognition of this very special day, we will have a mass, followed by a student speaker who will assume the character of Saint Teresa and share our Saint Teresa's life and works with the student body. At lunch the parent council will be in to sell rose cupcakes to students.

Next week we will be hosting our fall Scholastic Book Fair. Each class is assigned specific shopping times for the fair. Please see the schedule and directions below.

Believe it or not, the Eighth-grade class is starting to prepare for the high school admissions process. Thursday, October 5th from 5:30 to 7:00 we will be hosting our annual high school fair. Present will be Saint Raphael Academy, La Salle, Bayview, Hendricken, Saint Patrick's and Chesterton Academy. I would encourage any eighth grader (and their parents) who are considering a Catholic high school to attend.
