Principal Update

Dear Parents,

I hope this message finds you and your family in good spirits. As we embark on another week of learning and growth together, we are excited to share with you the latest updates, highlights, and upcoming events from our school community. From academic achievements to exciting extracurricular activities, there's plenty to celebrate and stay informed about. Thank you for your continued support and involvement in your child's education journey. Let's make this week a fantastic one!

The Chick Program began in second grade, compliments of Casey Farm, one of the oldest farms in Rhode Island! Each year an educator from Casey Farm visits the second-grade class and teaches our students about the life cycle of birds. They leave the class with the materials to incubate a clutch of eggs. They set up the equipment and involve our students in a hands-on presentation. Twenty-one days later, students will observe as the chick's hatch. The students will then take a field trip to Casey Farm, when they return the chicks to the farm.

Students in grades 3, 4, 5 just received copies of their newly published book, "The Adventures of Hammy", "Finding Hammy" and "Where in the World is Hammy?". Last fall, Hammy, the pet hamster in grade 3, disappeared. After being gone for several days, Hammy turned up in Miss Shelly's office! There was a lot of speculation as to how Hammy spent his time away and these speculations were turned into a creative writing assignment. The kids in grades 3, 4, and 5 wrote what they believed Hammy's adventures to be, and these adventures have been published in a different book for each of the grade levels.

Last Friday we hosted an assembly called NED's Mindset Mission. It was an encouraging assembly which taught students about the importance of a positive mindset for learning and life. Many yoyo tricks were performed as part of the assembly. It was provided to the school for free, but they do ask that we pay it forward by selling yoyos. Yoyos will be on sale next week. We will call classes down starting on Monday. They will also be available for purchase during lunch and recess. The following items will be on sale:

Two weeks ago, we asked families to complete a couple of surveys. The results of both surveys were positive. Consequently, we will begin planning for an optional year-long pre-k program beginning summer 2025. This summer (2024) we will be offering a summer enrichment program for students in grades two through seven. More information will be coming concerning this program.
