Dear Families and Friends

We hope this newsletter finds you well as we complete another week of growth and learning at Saint Teresa School. As we work together in faith and education, we continue to witness the remarkable achievements of our students and the dedication of our staff.

Last weekend Saint Teresa School was well represented at the Rhode Island Science and Engineering Fair. We would like

to thank Michael Cute, Manny DePina, Gianna-Leah Duarte and Cairo Carvalho for representing the school so well. The second grade had their visit from Casey Farm and are now anxiously waiting for their chicks to hatch. We'll keep you posted as to their progress. Music students in grades 3, 4, and 5 are learning to read and play music on the recorder. Later this spring they will have the opportunity to play with the Rhode Island Philharmonic. Middle school art students are preparing for a Night at the Museum, where a middle school art program will be showcased. Keep your eye out for more information.

Today I had the pleasure of attending a concert in the sixth grade. The performers were members of the 6th grade class who are in the Recycling Club. Members of the club had made instruments out of recycled materials, and they did an awesome job of playing and singing the music of Bruno Mars and Pharrell Williams.



Thanks to a grant with the City of Pawtucket, we have been able to partner with Boystown. Boystown offers support services to children and their families and one of the services that they provide is offering parent resources. This spring they will be hosting two Parent Café's at Saint Teresa's. One April 25th from 5:30 to 6:30 they will offer a workshop on Internet Safety and on May 23rd from 5:30 to 6:30 they will offer a workshop on Managing Your Child's Emotions. Today concluded our Stations of the Cross for the Lenten season. As students have participated in the Stations of the Cross they have been encouraged to reflect on the significance of this holy season. 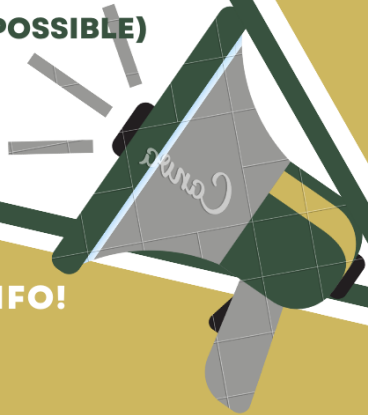

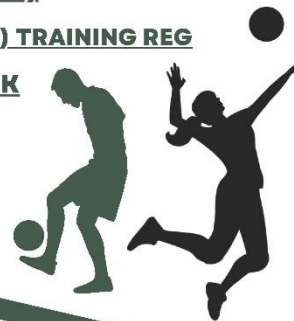
