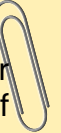

ACADEMIC UPDATES

Learning From the Past

Our Social Studies curriculum at Saint Teresa School continues to foster curiosity and an understanding of the world around us. Kindergarteners have been exploring the lives of inspiring figures like Helen Keller and Ray Charles in their unit on the five senses, learning how people adapt and overcome challenges. First graders are broadening their horizons by studying different modes of travel and learning about the United Kingdom. In third grade, students are developing map skills, while our fourth graders have been discovering the rich history of Rhode Island's founders. Fifth grade is diving into the culture and history of indigenous people of the United States, enriching their knowledge of our nation's origins. In middle school, sixth graders are exploring the wonders of ancient civilizations, while seventh grade is investigating the Salem Witch Trials and how religion has influenced history. Eighth grade will soon embark on an exciting journey into the Gold Rush era, deepening their understanding of America's past. Each grade's studies provide students with a meaningful look at history, geography, and culture, helping them make connections to the world and their faith.

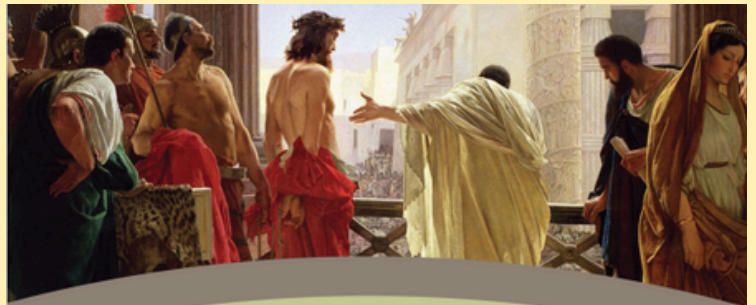

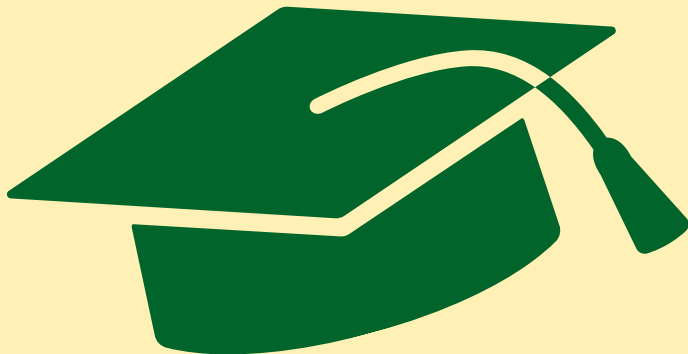


